

DON'T WAIT... REQUEST A BALLOT TODAY

“Why stand in line for the same ballot you can have mailed to your home?”

Consider these facts:

- ALL registered voters in Florida will be required to vote a paper ballot whether voting by mail, at an early voting site, or at the polls on Election Day
- Voters will not receive a paper receipt after voting
- Any registered voter may vote by mail
- Florida law requires ALL accepted mail ballots be included in the official final results
- You will automatically be mailed ballots, but can be cancelled at any time
- You can mail your ballot **OR** drop it off at one of the many drop sites throughout the county

To request a ballot by mail, choose a method that is easiest for you:
