Subject: Authorize expenditure to purchase services from Chemtrade.

Recommendation

Authorization to purchase services for maintaining the coagulation chemical utilized by the wastewater treatment facility from Chemtrade in an amount not to exceed \$20,000.

Background

Rule 62-610.460(3), Florida Administrative Code requires chemical feed facilities for a coagulant to control turbidity (or clarity) in the finished water at the wastewater treatment facility. Aluminum Sulfate is the coagulant that is utilized by the facility.

Our goal is to ensure the continual purchase of Aluminum Sulfate to comply with State regulations and to provide to highest quality treated water for the environment.
