Information Regarding the Cedar Street Improvement Project

In the next few weeks, the City of Tarpon Springs will begin a restoration project on Cedar Street. The project boundaries run from North Pinellas Avenue (Alternate U.S. Highway 19) west to the intersection of Arfaras Street.

The Cedar Street Improvement Project includes the restoration of the brick roadway. The street will be restored using as many of the existing bricks as possible. The project will also include improvements to the water and sewer utilities and installation of new stormwater drainage pipes. New ADA compliant sidewalks, curbing and driveways will also be addressed. Mailboxes may be replaced as needed. An aerial photo showing the project boundaries is provided below:



Note:

- Construction will begin soon. The City will be working closely with the contractor during construction to minimize disruption to your daily life.
- Access will be maintained at all times for local traffic, however detours may be necessary at times.
- All utilities will be maintained during construction. New drinking water pipe will be installed during the road/sidewalk phase of the project.
- The project is expected to be completed in about 6 months, with estimated completion by mid-summer 2019.
