Subject: Authorize a Single Source Purchase for HACH Equipment, Service and Maintenance

Recommendation

Authorize a Single Source contract be issued to HACH Company in the amount of \$50,000 for the period of October 19, 2018 to October 18, 2019. Purchases will include supplies, equipment, and maintenance services for the RO Facility and Wastewater operations.

Background

HACH is the sole source provider for several analytical equipment items at the Water and Sewer Facilities. These components and supplies are used for measuring water quality parameters in laboratory analysis, distribution sample measurements, and online instrumentation.
