During Hurricane Irma, many City employees remained on duty to monitor the storm's progress and its impact on the City of Tarpon Springs. Many were also responsible for serving on quick strike forces to go out immediately after the storm to assess damage and clear major roadways. We are very proud of all of our great employees who left their families and worked through the night to make Tarpon Springs a safer place! Our state of the art Emergency Operations Center (EOC) was the hub of activity for the three days of activation from Sunday through Tuesday evening. The EOC is housed in our Public Safety Facility on Huey Avenue. Debris pick up began September 18th and will continue for approximately 60 days. The magnitude of the debris left behind by Irma is extreme. We thank all of our residents for being patient while we gather and dispose of the mess left by Irma. We are deeply thankful that the damage left behind was not much worse and we keep all of those that have suffered great losses during the recent storm season in our thoughts.

Amendment 1: Will you benefit?

On November 6 all voters in Florida will make an important decision about a proposed third Homestead Exemption.

The Pinellas County Property Appraiser has developed a tool that you can use to determine to what extent the proposal will affect your tax bill. You can run the estimator at 3hxevaluator.org to find out if you will receive any exemption benefit from the proposal. The full benefit (\$25,000) from the 3rd Homestead Exemption is not received unless your property's assessed value is greater than or equal to \$125,000.
