



## Pent Street and Grosse Avenue Drainage and Roadway Improvements – 60% Design

On behalf of the City of Tarpon Springs, we invite you to come learn about the Pent Street and Grosse Avenue Drainage and Roadway Improvement project.

As part of the City's on-going stormwater capital improvement projects associated with its Stormwater Action Plan (SAP), the City's Public Works Department has partnered with the Pinellas County School Board and the Southwest Florida Water Management District on a stormwater flood protection and water quality improvement project. The project involves installing a new stormwater collection system along N. Grosse Avenue, construction of two new stormwater management facilities, and improving two existing stormwater management facilities. The stormwater improvement project aims to reduce the historic and frequent flooding at the following locations: Tarpon Avenue (Hurricane Evacuation route) just east of N. Grosse Avenue, Cypress Street between N. Grosse Avenue and N. Levis Avenue, Pent Street between N. Grosse Avenue and N. Levis Avenue, the N. Grosse Avenue / Pine Street intersection, Spruce Street between N. Grosse Avenue and N. Levis Avenue, and N. Grosse Avenue between Tarpon Avenue and Pine Street. The construction of two new stormwater management facilities and improvements to two existing stormwater management facilities will also provide additional water quality treatment for the Anclote River.



The purpose of this public meeting is to provide an open format with the local residences to inform them about the project, to discuss specific concerns that the residences may have, and to answer any questions. There will be a brief presentation followed by an opportunity to talk with with engineers and City representatives about the project.
