**RE: Public Art Committee Purchase** 

The Public Art Committee (PAC) has selected to purchase a bronze sculpture called "Storytime" by renowned sculptress Glenna Goodacre for \$50,000, plus \$200 shipping from Sarasota, Florida to be installed at the Cultural Center, 101 S. Pinellas Ave. (at the corner of Lemon and S. Pinellas Avenue). The sculpture depicts a mother and child seated on a teak park bench reading a book. This site was selected because the first library was located on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor of the Cultural Center and the Tarpon Springs Public Library is a short block away on Lemon Street.

"Storytime" is available for sale through the Galleria Silecchia, 20 S. Palm Ave, Sarasota, FL 34236. Prior to installation of the sculptures at the Cultural Center, a concrete base would be installed and lighting to illuminate the statue after dark. This may involve storing the sculptures until the base work is completed.

This installation will draw visitors to Tarpon Springs to view these life-size sculptures, by this nationally celebrated artist and serve as a "key" public art anchor for the area.

Glenna Goodacre's work is also located in key areas of Sarasota and sold to the City for significant sums of money. For example, the "Olympic Wannabes" installed at Sarasota's Selby Five Points Park was \$180,000 for the five bronze figures.

The PAC would like to move forward and purchase the "Storytime" sculpture as soon as it is feasible.
