

## Public Notice -Reclaimed Water Usage Restrictions in Effect

Issued 3/10/17

Please be advised that the City of Tarpon Springs is continuing with **Phase II reclaimed water usage restrictions** due to experiencing drought like conditions.

*The restriction phases are described in the table below.* The conservation of our reclaimed water will help ensure that reclaimed water service remains available as much as possible during these conditions of lack of rainfall and increased irrigation demand. Such conditions may be expected to remain in place for approximately the next three months until our normal rainy season begins.

Should the Phase II restriction not provide the required demand relief, the City may be required to implement Phase III restriction, further limiting watering days.

### Reclaimed Water Restriction Phased Plan

Phase I	<b>Voluntarily</b> reducing reclaimed water usage to 2 days per week outside of the hours of 10 am to 4 pm to maximize the effectiveness of irrigation
Phase II	<b>Voluntarily</b> reducing reclaimed water usage to 2 days per week outside of the hours of 10 am to 4 pm to maximize the effectiveness of irrigation & <b>Mandatory</b> interruptions of service as needed during the hours of 10 am to 4 pm to minimize waste from evaporation and assist in maintaining supply
Phase III	<b>Mandatory</b> limited watering days citywide, with interruptions in service as required to restore supply.  Initially, <b>reclaimed water service will not be available on Tuesdays and Fridays</b> to allow storage tanks to be filled. If drought conditions persist and reclaimed water supply is not sufficient, additional off days will be required.

We greatly appreciate your assistance in conserving our important but limited reclaimed water supply.
