## **Project Update – Westwinds and Grassy Pointe Residential Reclaimed Water Project**

Dear Residents:

This courtesy letter is to provide an update status and additional information to those City residents that will soon be enjoying the benefit of saving money and conserving potable quality water by irrigating with reclaimed water. To briefly summarize, the upcoming project consists of installation of new reclaimed water distribution lines and associated improvements to serve approximately 310 residential customers in the Westwinds and Grassy Pointe communities. Funding is being provided by the City along with portions covered by a grant from the Southwest Florida Water Management District (SWFWMD). One of the City's priorities will be to work closely with the contractor during construction to minimize disruption to your daily life.

- Construction is estimated to begin in the summer of 2018 and is expected to continue for approximately 10-12 months, resulting in an estimated project completion during spring/early summer of 2019.
- Site access will be maintained to provide local traffic access and minimize disturbances to the neighborhoods. Construction will occur during normal business hours on weekdays.
- All water and sewer utilities will be maintained during construction. If you choose to connect to the new reclaimed water system, the piping/meters will be installed, tested, and put into service prior to removal of potable water irrigation meters (if applicable) so there would be no lapse of service for irrigation.

We will continue to provide timely status updates as will strive to communicate important project milestones. Thank you for your continued patience, understanding and ongoing cooperation.
