## Reminder Water Conservation Measures Still in Effect

Please note that the City of Tarpon Springs maintains watering restrictions for our customers that are generally *more strict than the SWFWMD and county restrictions*. Watering from all sources (except reclaimed water) for irrigation and car washing are limited to *once per week*. Irrigation should only be performed between the hours 6:00 pm to 8:00 am.

With the drought that has been occurring in our area this winter and with potable water always at a premium, there is no better time to take a look at the things we can do to reduce our consumption of this extremely valuable resource. As a community, it is important that we all work together to save water and there are many ways to accomplish that goal. Small things like turning off the tap while brushing your teeth or washing hands and repairing any leaky faucets or toilets can reduce water bills and save water. Two of the easiest and most effective ways to reduce consumption are to limit car washing and irrigation times as much as possible and only watering lawns during night time or early morning hours to reduce evaporation and allow as much water to make it to the plant root system as possible. This is why our City has set forth watering restrictions for irrigation and car washing as a way to help reduce water consumption and make sure we are conserving our valuable resource.
